SERMON PHILOSOPHY

These checkpoints are intended to develop a well-rounded and systematic approach to discipleship through preaching.

CHECKPOINT	DESCRIPTION OF CHECKPOINT
1. SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES	These will focus on developing spiritual disciplines within the life of a believer.
2. AUTHENTIC FAITH	These will focus on developing a proper understanding of our faith and doctrines.
3. HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS	These will focus on developing healthy relationships whether it is with God or others.
4. HISTORICAL FIGURE	These will focus on developing a greater understanding of how we can learn from people in Scripture.
5. BOOK STUDY	These will focus on developing a better understanding of the Gospel through a specific book of the Bible.

CHECKPOINT	SERMON SERIES TITLE: BIG IDEA
HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS / BOOK STUDY (NT)	The Journey in Galilee (Luke 4-9): Jesus spent most of His ministry in the area known as Galilee. Luke's Christological goal is to present Jesus to the Greeks as the perfect human and Savior, the Son of Man, and the Savior of all men.
AUTHENTIC FAITH / BOOK STUDY (NT)	The Journey to Jerusalem (Luke 10-19): Luke tells us about Jesus' final trip from Galilee to Jerusalem. Luke's historical purpose is to present an accurate account of the life and ministry of Jesus Christ, "so that you may know the exact truth" (Luke 1:14).
AUTHENTIC FAITH (BOOK STUDY (NT)	The Journey through Jerusalem (Luke 20-24): Luke provides an historical account of the passion week of Christ.
HISTORICAL FIGURES / BOOK STUDY (NT)	The Journey of Peter (Acts 1-12): The book of Acts is the sequel to Luke's gospel account. The first twelve chapters focus on the ministry of Peter and highlight several key historical figures in the beginnings of the church.
HISTORICAL FIGURES / BOOK STUDY (NT)	The Journey of Paul (Paul's Ministry: Acts 13-28): The second half of the book of Acts focuses on the ministry of Paul and his missionary journeys and ultimate destination of Rome.
SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES	40 Days of Missional Living: A 40-day journey focused on the Great Commission. The emphasis of the series is to make personal application of the Great Commission that Jesus gave to His church.
HISTORICAL FIGURES / BOOK STUDY (OT)	The Journey to Bethlehem: Part 1 (Ruth): A young widow named Ruth follows her mother-in-law from Moab to Bethlehem. Her journey paves the way for Bethlehem becoming "The City of David" from which the Messiah will be born.
HISTORICAL FIGURE & BOOK STUDY (NT)	The Journey to Bethlehem: Part 2 (Luke 1-3): "For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." The Gospel According to Luke begins with the announcement and birth of the Savior.
